

# Nogales, AZ Produce



- <u>5.9 BILLION pounds of Produce</u> imported to the U.S. through Nogales every year.
- More than 300 produce houses in Nogales.
- More than 50 types of Mexican-grown fruits and vegetables imported to the U.S. through Nogales, AZ Port of Entry.
- 147,500 truckloads per year!

#### **Total Produce Distributed in the CFBSA Service Area (Pounds)**







- 12,930,000 pounds of just tomatoes!



















- 20,871 pallets of produce (YTD)


#### Where do we go from here?

- Based on an ordering system rather than offers, with a produce mixing center to support the co-op to be located at CFBSA-Tucson.









# CARING MINISTRIES

- Grocery Rescue Partner Picking up seventy grocery stores six days a week
- Produce Distribution Partner Sixty pallets of bulk produce every week
- Community Support Partner Supporting 48 churches and 6 food pantries
  - > Caring Ministries distributes 10,000 food boxes every month
  - ➤ Serving 20,000 people every month and 240,000 people every year
