

Have you been the victim of theft from your EBT card since October 1, 2022?

In December 2022, Congress passed a law to protect and replace EBT (SNAP & TANF) benefits stolen via card skimming, card cloning, phishing scams, and other fraudulent methods. The Arizona Department of Economic Security (DES) will begin implementing its approved state plan to replace benefits stolen through these methods on June 19, 2023.



Beginning June 19th, 2023 you can submit a form by:

- 1. Downloading it from the DES website at https://des.az.gov/services/basic-needs/food-assistance/nutrition-assistance/ebt-card and mailing or faxing it in.
- 2. Completing a form over the phone with a DES worker and verbally signing.
- 3. Completing in person at a DES office. Find your closest DES office at https://des.az.gov/find-your-local-office.
- You have 90 calendar days from June 19th, 2023 to report for EBT theft that occurred between October 1, 2022 and June 18th, 2023.
- You will have 45 calendar days, from the date the electronic benefit theft occurred on or after June 19th, 2023.
