Here's how you can help:



Donate funds to AzFBN, food banks, and smaller food pantries. Funds donated typically go further (dollar for dollar) than food donations do, but ask the organization you want to support what they need.



Call your federal lawmakers in the House and Senate and let them know about the real impact that is happening in your community.



Share with your friends, neighbors, and family if they need it, and ask what they need. Preventing people from needing to visit a food bank will help people who don't have these support systems.



Start a small "give or get" pantry in your area. Think about things like easy access, weather and animal/insect-proofing, and monitoring for trash and safety. Community response brings us together. Even small offerings help.



Volunteer at your local food pantry or at a food bank. Food banks are likely going to be (thankfully) overwhelmed with people wanting to help, so **please bring patience** to your interactions.



Remember that there is a whole work force dedicated to working at food banks year-round, and they are experiencing something that we have never seen. If you know someone who works or regularly volunteers in hunger relief, offer a sign of support.
