2026 Primary and General Election | Registration, Deadlines, and more



Important Dates

Election	Election Date*	Last Day to Register
2026 Primary Election**	July 21, 2026	June 22, 2026
2026 General Election	November 3, 2026	October 5, 2026

*You must register at least 29 days prior to the election
 **You may only vote in the Primary if you are affiliated with a political party

Am I Eligible to Register?

You are eligible if you are all of the following...

- U.S. Citizen
- Arizona resident
- 18 years or older on or before the General Election

What Documents do I need to Register?

To register to vote in Arizona, you must prove you are both a citizen and a resident. See the table below for the types of documents you need to provide for each requirement.

Proof of Citizenship You only need <u>ONE</u> of the documents below	Proof of Residency You only need <u>ONE</u> of the documents below
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AZ driver's license or non-operating ID issued after Oct. 1, 1996 • Legible copy of a birth certificate (include name-change docs if needed) • Copy of pertinent pages of your U.S. passport • U.S. naturalization documents, Alien Registration Number, Naturalization Certificate Number, or Citizenship Certificate Number (Box 11) • Indian Census Number, BIA Number, Tribal Treaty Card, or Tribal Enrollment Number (Box 10) • Copy of Tribal Certificate of Indian Blood or Tribal/BIA Affidavit of Birth <p>*Do not submit original documents</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid AZ driver's license or nonoperating ID • Any Tribal identification document (census card, tribal gov't ID, enrollment card) • Utility bill, or bank/credit union statement dated within 90 days • Valid AZ vehicle registration • Property tax statement • U.S. federal, state, or local government-issued ID (including a voter registration card) • Any mailing marked "Official Election Material" <p>No fixed address? How do I Register?

Online

If you have an AZ Driver's license or AZ Non-Operating ID you can register to vote at azmvdnow.gov/vr or the QR code below.



By Mail

Include copies of your citizenship and residency documents and mail to your county recorder's office.

In Person

Early Voting and Mail in Ballots

Arizona voters can request an early ballot by mail. If you are interested in joining the permanent early voting list or requesting a one-time ballot-by-mail, go to azsos.gov/elections/voters/early-voting.

What to Bring on Election Day

- One valid form of ID (photo or non-photo accepted)
- If using a non-photo ID, bring two documents that show your name and address (see residency documents on page 1)
- No ID? You may cast a provisional ballot that will be separately validated by the state.

Poll workers can help - don't let ID concerns stop you from showing up.
